Start by lifting lighter loads like for example empty pallets, so that you become more accustomed with the reach function of the lift truck. When the pallet is securely attached to the tines, tilt them back so the load is safely resting against the grate. This safety grate is situated behind the forks and keeps the load from sliding. Set pallets down where preferred by reversing the process. Tilt the forks down over the intended site and level them. The pallets should effortlessly slide away from the safety grate. Set the pallets down.
